Science

Cite evidence from the text to answer the question. (R.A.C.E)

Sensory receptors on your body get information from the environment. Some of this information travels to your brain, which processes it. Then it sends information to your body to take action.

Animals use these same senses, or **variations** of these senses, to get the information they need to survive in their environments. Some animals use senses that are beyond the reach of humans.

Rattlesnakes are members of a family of snakes called pitvipers. Pitvipers have a sensory receptor on their face that detects heat. With this structure, rattlesnakes locate **prey** such as mice and rats. These small animals give off body heat. The snakes can sense the heat. Put a blindfold on a rattlesnake, and it can still sense and capture prey. A rattlesnake can find a meal even in complete darkness.
