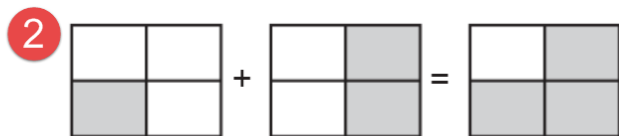

### **The Abolitionists**

During the 1800s, many reforms, or changes, took place in American society. **Abolitionists** were reformers who felt that slavery should be erased, or abolished, from the land. The abolitionist movement began in the Northeast during the 1800s. Since the early days of the colonies, Africans had been captured and brought to the Americas as slaves. A **slave** is a person who is owned as property by another person. Slaves often had no rights. They had to do whatever their masters wished. Abolitionists organized groups and published newspapers against slavery. They held meetings. At some of these meetings, Frederick Douglass and Sojourner Truth spoke about their lives as slaves. They worked for the freedom of all people, including slaves and women. In 1865, after the Civil War, the Thirteenth Amendment was added to the Constitution. The amendment ended slavery in the United States.
